144c1 - Smoking Area Guidelines

1. Requirements

2600.

144.c. A home that permits smoking inside or outside of the home shall develop and implement written fire safety policy and procedures that include the following:

- 1. Proper safeguards inside and outside of the home to prevent fire hazards involved in smoking, including providing fireproof receptacles and ashtrays, direct outside ventilation, no interior ventilation from the smoking room through other parts of the home, extinguishing procedures, fire resistant furniture both inside and outside the home and fire extinguishers in the smoking rooms.

Description of Violation

Resident #1 has been observed smoking in [redacted] bedroom or the common bathroom on approximately 10 occasions since [redacted] 2021. Resident #1 has also been in violation of the rules in the homes designated smoking area.

Plan of Correction

We have reviewed the policy with Resident #1 on numerous occasions and have posted non-smoking signs in [redacted] bedroom. Non-smoking signs are also posted in various locations throughout the building and on doors. In addition, fireproof smoking receptacles in outside designated areas have been shown on several occasions and explained on several occasions. Attached are photos of some of the signs.

If after an oral warning followed by a written warning that have both been documented, the home should issue a 30 day notice to this resident for failure to follow the Home Rules. I assume that the Home does have no smoking in the home rules and a copy of the Home Rules was attached to the Original Contract.
