Dear Mr. Johnson:

On February 24, 2010, a criminal complaint was filed by the Delaware County District Attorney's Office charging Mr. Richard McKnight, personal care home administrator of Stapeley in Germantown, with twelve criminal charges relating to theft and possession of controlled substances.

In accordance with 55 Pa.Code § 2600.15(b) (relating to abuse reporting covered by law) and 6 Pa.Code § 15.156(a)-(b) (relating to restriction on employees), Mr. McKnight is immediately, and until further notice from the Department, prohibited from access to the property and premises of the above licensed personal care home. Mr. McKnight is also prohibited from access to any resident of the above personal care home at any time while residents are off the premises of the personal care home. Mr. McKnight also prohibited access to all records of the home, including resident records and finances.


Failure to comply with this prohibition may result in license action against your personal care home.

If you disagree with the decision to prohibit Mr. McKnight's access to the personal care home and the residents, you have the right to appeal through hearing before the Bureau of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Public Welfare in accordance with 1 Pa.Code Part II, Chs. 31-35. Appeal of this action does NOT permit Mr. McKnight to have access to the personal care home, the property, the residents or the records.

If you decide to appeal, a written request for an appeal must be received within 10 days of the date of this letter by:
