The reason for the regulation is that the Agency on Aging is aware and that the home is acting on the suspected abuse incident.

The home did not realize that Agency on Aging was to be notified separately from the Department of Public Welfare.

Maria Hall will write a Policy and Procedure on the steps we will take when abuse is noticed or reported.

- Post the Policy for staff
- Add to Policy and Procedure Book
- Inservice staff on the proper steps to be taken

Steps will be reviewed monthly at the regular staff meetings.

The Administrator and Director of Resident Care will work together to see that resident abuse does not happen again at Maria Hall.

The Policy and Procedure will be written by July 5, and added to the Policy and Procedure Book by July 6. An inservice for all staff will be given on July 19, 2011.

An inservice on Act 13 will be given on July 20 for all direct care staff, which will include nurses, aides, housekeepers and maintenance personnel. The times of inservice will be 7:30 AM and 2:30 PM.
