The last fire safety inspection conducted by a fire safety expert was on 8/24/11.

The last fire drill conducted by a fire safety expert was on 8/31/11.

Personal contact with the Parker Volunteer Fire Dept. chief was attempted numerous times the summer of 2012, prior to August 24, 2012 – to maintain the yearly compliance for the performance of the inspection and drill.

Parker VFD set a date of September 5, 2012 – after compliance date was past. On September 5, 2012 Parker VFD was responding to a true emergency call.

In as much , as the Parker VFD meets only the first Wednesday of every month, a new date for the yearly drill was set for October 15, 2012, by the entire fire company and the inspection was done September 25, 2012, by the fire chief. The two events were done as promised on the latter dates. Please see the attached letters from Parker VFD to Parker PCH.

Agreement was co-ordinated between Parker VFD and Parker PCH's administrator for future yearly requests and appointments. The administrator of Parker PCH will send Parker VFD a certified or registered letter containing written request for the yearly inspection and drill – two to three months prior to the due date. Parker VFD has agreed to set several dates within the yearly parameters, in case of an emergency occurrence, again. Parker VFD will notify Parker PCH administrator with the dates available and try to perform on the first date available. This will prevent the PCH from being deficient with annual fire inspections and drills.
