On February 1, 2013, the Department of Public Welfare (Department) streamlined and modernized the human services licensing process such that licenses to operate are issued to currently-licensed providers upon receipt of their annual renewal application for licensure.

The Department has received your July 17, 2013 renewal application to operate the above Personal Care Home pursuant to Title 55, PA Code, Chapter 2600. A regular license is being issued in response to your application. Your license is enclosed.

Please be advised that, pursuant to 55 Pa. Code § 20.31 (relating to annual inspection), the Department is required to conduct an onsite inspection of the above Personal Care Home at least once every twelve months. The Department will conduct an inspection of Longwood At Oakmont Personal Care Center within the next twelve months. If evidence of noncompliance with Title 55, PA Code, Chapter 2600 is found during the inspection, the Department will take appropriate enforcement action.
