**1. REGULATION 55 Pa.Code §2600**

2600.183(b) - Prescription medications, OTC medications, CAM and syringes shall be kept in an area or container that is locked. This includes medications and syringes kept in the resident's room.

**2a. DESCRIPTION OF VIOLATION**

On 9/9/2013, during the administrator's routine walk through of the resident rooms, Administrator A noticed bottles of acetaminophen in plain view in resident # 1's bedroom. As per the home's policy residents are prohibited from storing medications in their room.

The administrator educated the consumer on the home's policy regarding medication storage. All medications, prescription or OTC will be scripted by a physician and be kept locked in the medication room at all times. The house rules currently only covered prohibited use of alcohol and street drugs. The house rules will be changed to include the prohibited use of any OTC drugs as well. The residents will be given a 30 day notice that this house rule is going to change on 10/31/13, making the new rule effective 11/30/13.

\* The administrator will continue to perform her routine walk throughs of the facility to ensure everything is within the licensing regulations. If the administrator notices any other OTC drugs in a resident's room, they will be removed and an incident report will be completed.
