As a result of your facility's recent adjustment of the use of physical space, we are issuing a revised license under the authority of 55 Pa.Code Ch. 2600 (relating to Personal Care Homes). The revised license indicates a revised licensed capacity for your facility. The expiration date of the license remains unchanged. Your revised license is enclosed.
