-On April 24, 2014, a 3 ounce box of ICYBAY Oven Ready Imitation Crab Cakes was opened, and not properly sealed.
 -On April 24, 2014, an 8 ounce box of breadsticks opened, and not properly sealed.

Ongoing, the Director of Dining Services will monitor weekly to ensure food storage is done appropriately.
