**1. REGULATION 55 Pa. Code §2600**  
 2600.15(a) - The home shall immediately report suspected abuse of a resident served in the home in accordance with the Older Adults Protective Services Act (35 P.S. Sections 10225.701 - 10225.707) and 6 Pa. Code Sections 15.21 - 15.27 (relating to reporting suspected abuse) and comply with the requirements regarding restrictions on staff persons.

**2a. DESCRIPTION OF VIOLATION**  
 Department Representatives determined that resident #1 reported to staff person A several times within the last month, that resident #2 was hitting and punching resident #1. Staff person A failed to report these allegations of resident to resident abuse as required under the Older Adult Protective Services Act.

Staff person A has been re-trained on the mandatory reporting of all abuse or suspected abuse as outlined in the older adult protective services act. Administrator will do periodic refresher trainings during scheduled staff meeting throughout the calendar year to ensure every employee understands the importance of reporting abuse. Administrator will report all abuse and suspected abuse to the department and the local area agency on aging within 24 hrs of notification.
