Thank you for your request for a waiver of 55 Pa.Code Ch. 2600 (relating to personal care homes). You have requested a waiver of 55 Pa.Code § 2600.231(g) (relating to admission) for the facility listed above.

A waiver of 55 Pa.Code § 2600.231(g) (relating to admission) is hereby granted under the authority of 55 Pa.Code § 2600.19 (relating to waivers).

This waiver is granted on the following conditions:

1. This waiver applies to Barnabas Court at Brevillier Village, License #: 453060, located at 5416 East Lake Road, Erie, Pennsylvania, 16511.
2. This waiver applies to the following residents currently residing in the licensed personal care home: [REDACTED]
3. [REDACTED] shall have the right to exit the secured dementia care unit immediately upon request.
4. At all times, an on-site direct care staff person shall be accessible and available to assist [REDACTED] with egress from the secured dementia care unit immediately upon request.
5. Within seven (7) days from the date of this letter, all current direct care staff persons shall be trained on the conditions of this waiver. All new direct care staff persons will be trained on the conditions of this waiver prior to or during the first work day. Barnabas Court at Brevillier Village shall maintain a record of initial training including the staff person trained, date, source, content and length of each course for each direct care staff person employed by the home.

6. For the duration of this waiver, all direct care staff persons will receive annual training on the conditions of this waiver. Barnabas Court at Brevillier Village will maintain a record of annual training including the staff person trained, date, source, content and length of each course for each direct care staff person employed by the home.

This waiver is in effect for as long as the conditions under which the waiver is granted continue to be met. The Department will review this waiver each year during its annual inspection to determine compliance with the preceding conditions. Failure to comply with the conditions of this waiver or with other requirements of 55 Pa.Code Chapter 2600 may result in termination of this waiver or other licensing action.
