

§ 2800.191. Resident education.

The residence shall educate the resident of the right to question or refuse a medication if the resident believes there may be a medication error. Documentation of this resident education shall be kept.

Violation

The residence did not have documentation for Residents #1, #2 and #3 that they have been educated of their right to question or refuse a medication if they believe there may be a medication error.

Plan of Correction

Residents #1, 2 and 3 have been educated on their right to refuse or question medications and have completed a signed acknowledgement. All resident files have been audited for a acknowledgement of right to refuse medications and any residents who did not have a signed acknowledgement have been educated on their right to refuse or question. This was completed on June 24, 2015. The resident agreement has been revised to include the right to question or refuse medications as part of resident rights which all residents sign at time of admission. All direct care staff have been educated on the resident's right to question or refuse medication by the administrator. This will be completed on June 30, 2015. Administrator will audit new resident admission agreements for the next three months to ensure that there is a signed acknowledgement of right to refuse and question medications.
