1. REGULATION 55 Pa.Code §2600
 2600.42(s) - A resident has the right to privacy of self and possessions. Privacy shall be provided to the resident during bathing, dressing, changing and medical procedures.

2a. DESCRIPTION OF VIOLATION
 The home has four cameras recording activities occurring in common areas of the home.
 Cameras are designated numbers and include:
 # 12 located on the ground floor ceiling at the intersection of hallways C and B. The camera records activities occurring in all four hallways including residents sitting in the hallways and entering and leaving the kitchen, computer room and laundry room.
 # 13 located on the right side ceiling of the lobby, aimed left, recording the seating areas and front doors.
 # 14 located outside the cafeteria recording residents entering and leaving the cafeteria, sitting in the hallway and waiting outside the accounting office.
 # 34 located on the left side ceiling of the lobby, aimed right, recording the seating areas and front doors.
 There are no signs indicating that images are being recorded posted in the areas where recording is occurring.

3. PLAN OF CORRECTION (POC) (Attach pages as necessary. Remember that you must sign and date any attached pages.)
Include steps to correct the violation described above and steps to prevent a similar violation from occurring again. If steps cannot be completed immediately, include dates by which the steps will be completed.

Hollidaysburg Veterans' Home (HVH) will contact Wacor Electronic Systems (contractor for HVH camera system). Wacor Electronic Systems will disable the recording feature of Camera 12, 13, 14, and 34. The completion date will be November 30th 2015 based on the current Pennsylvania State budget not being passed. Until the budget is passed, HVH is unable to provide funds to a contractor for performing this task.
 In addition, HVH has posted signs indicating that video recording is in progress. These signs will accompany the current signs that read "video surveillance is in progress."
 Please see the attached appeal.
