Dear Mr. Ohlendorf and Mr. Granahan:

On February 18, 2016, the Department of Human Services (Department) issued a notice of its intent to assess a fine for regulatory violations with 55 Pa.Code Ch. 2600 (relating to personal care homes) for the above personal care home.

Pursuant to 62 P.S. §§ 1085-1087 and 55 Pa.Code §§ 2600.261-268 (relating to enforcement), the Department hereby assesses a fine for the following uncorrected violations. Brookdale Grandon Farms continues to advertise as an Assisted Living residence on <https://www.brookdale.com/locations/pennsylvania/>.

Total Fine Assessment for period of February 19, 2016 through March 4, 2016 = \$4,230.

The enclosed Invoice for Personal Care Home Fine specifies the total amount of the fines for the period following the Department's notice of intent to assess a fine. The invoice is payable within 30 days from the mailing date of this letter. The fines will continue to accumulate and will be recalculated at the end of each month until all violations are fully corrected. You must notify the Department's Regional Human Services Licensing office in writing as soon as each violation is fully corrected and submit written documentation of each correction. Even if you pay the full amount of this invoice, fines will continue to accumulate for each violation until you have provided written notice of full correction and the Department has verified that the violations are fully corrected.

In accordance with §2600.268 (relating to notice of violations), the personal care home administrator shall immediately post this written notice in a conspicuous and public place in the home, if this notice includes a Class I violation.

If you disagree with the decision to assess a fine, you have the right to appeal through hearing before the Bureau of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Human Services in accordance with 1 Pa.Code Part II, Chs. 31-35 and 62 P.S. §1086(f). If you decide to appeal, a written request for an appeal with a check made payable to the "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania" for the total monthly fine amount or \$500, whichever is less, must be received within 30 days of the mailing date of this letter by:



On February 22nd, 2016 the Director of Marketing Strategy for the Northeast Division, Brookdale Senior Living ("Brookdale") confirmed that the following actions were completed:

- All Pennsylvania Brookdale Senior Living community web pages were updated to use the term "Assistive Senior Living".
- All national and brand level digital advertising (pay-per-click, retargeting and associated web landing pages) have been corrected to use the term "Assistive Senior Living" in Pennsylvania;
- On February 12, 2016 the ad copy in all existing ads targeted to Pennsylvania from National and Brand campaigns were changed to "assistive senior living", with the exception of the Community campaigns which are initiated by the individual communities using a template.
- Marketing campaign materials have been updated to provide communities with a drop down customization option for "Assistive Senior Living" on all customizable marketing pieces
- As of February 22, 2016, all of the Facebook pages for Brookdale communities located in Pennsylvania have been changed to unpublished pages as we are continuing to establish the manner and timeline to correct the language on the Facebook pages, which includes the "Assisted Living" descriptor.
- All advertisement campaigns pertaining to Brookdale personal care homes in Pennsylvania have been updated to use the language "Assistive Senior Living".
- The communities have changed templates for the Pennsylvania communities on their web pages, which is a simple template selection in the interface they use to upload that information when specialized marketing materials are generated at the community level.

Training-

All Pennsylvania communities were trained on their specific community calendars posted on www.brookdale.com, and how to self-select the appropriate Brookdale calendar template and not the assisted living calendar template. A training session was held on February 25, 2016, by the District Director Operations for Executive Directors and or designees in each Pennsylvania community pertaining to management of their external marketing communications/ brochures and changing community templates for web and Facebook applications.
