
1. REGULATION 85 Pa.Code §2800
 2600.103(f) - Food requiring refrigeration shall be stored at or below 40°F. Frozen food shall be kept at or below 0°F. Thermometers are required in refrigerators and freezers.

2a. DESCRIPTION OF VIOLATION
 There was no thermometer in the freezer on the 1st floor where food is stored for residents.
 There was no thermometer in the freezer in the basement where the meats are stored for the residents. The freezer did have an external thermometer but the temperature read 10 degrees fahrenheit which exceeds mandated limits.

The missing freezer thermometers were replaced and the freezer temperature in the basement was adjusted to meet standards.
