1. REGULATION 55 Pa.Code §2600

2600.103(e) - Food served and returned from an individual's plate may not be served again or used in the preparation of other dishes. Leftover food shall be labeled and dated.

2a. DESCRIPTION OF VIOLATION

On 10/13, at approximately 10am, there was a leftover half of a turkey sandwich in a ziplock bag in the refrigerator without a label or date.

3. PLAN OF CORRECTION (POC) (Attach pages as necessary. Remember that you must sign and date any attached pages.)

Include steps to correct the violation described above and steps to prevent a similar violation from occurring again. If steps cannot be completed immediately, include dates by which the steps will be completed.

At time of inspection a bagged left over sandwich that was not labeled was located in the refrigerator. The unlabeled food was removed from the refrigerator and discarded immediately. Staff in this home has been retrained on safe food handling and labeling of food in the home to ensure proper information regarding the identity of food items and the length of time food has been in storage to prevent cross-contamination of food and the use of expired food items. See attached training. Administrator will do periodic checks to assure compliance.

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

1. REGULATION 55 Pa.Code §2600
 2600.103(f) - Food requiring refrigeration shall be stored at or below 40°F. Frozen food shall be kept at or below 0°F. Thermometers are required in refrigerators and freezers.

2a. DESCRIPTION OF VIOLATION

- The refrigerator in the home's kitchen did not have a thermometer.
- The freezer chest in the home's basement did not have a thermometer.

During inspection kitchen refrigerator thermometer and basement freezer chest did not have thermometers. New thermometers were placed in both units to ensure that foods are stored at safe temperatures. At time of inspection staff working was not aware the refrigerator thermometer was located in drawer thus unable to show thermometer to inspector. All Beechwood Center 7 staff received instruction regarding necessity of thermometers being present in refrigerators and freezers to insure refrigerator temperature to be at or below 40 degrees Fahrenheit and frozen food shall be kept at or below 0 degrees Fahrenheit. Monthly checks will be conducted by the Administrator to assure compliance.

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
