65.f. Training topics for the annual training for direct care staff persons shall include the following:

1. Medication self-administration training.
2. Instruction on meeting the needs of the residents as described in the preadmission screening form, assessment tool, medical evaluation and support plan.
3. Care for residents with dementia and cognitive impairments.
4. Infection control and general principles of cleanliness and hygiene and areas associated with immobility, such as prevention of decubitus ulcers, incontinence, malnutrition and dehydration.
5. Personal care service needs of the resident.
6. Safe management techniques.
7. Care for residents with mental illness or an intellectual disability, or both, if the population is served in the home.

Description of Violation

Direct care staff person A did not receive training in instruction on meeting the needs of the residents as described in the preadmission screening form, assessment tool, medical evaluation and support plan; medication self-administration; care for residents with dementia and cognitive impairments; or personal service care needs of the resident during the 2018 training year.


Plan of Correction (POC)

Direct care staff attend monthly trainings/ staff meetings. Personal Care Needs, Care of Residents with Mental Health Diagnosis and Medication updates and review are included in the regularly scheduled monthly meetings. The 2020 Direct Care Staff Training Plan include more specifically the following topics: preadmission screening form, assessment tool, medical evaluations and support plan. The training plan for 2020 is attached. Residents with dementia and cognitive impairments do not meet criteria for admissions to Women of Hope.

Administrator or designee will ensure all direct care staff persons are trained in all aspects of regulation 2600.65f which includes residents with mental illness or an intellectual disability if that population will be served in the home. SP 04-16-2020
