Mr. Bashore-Steury:

As the result of your home's recent request to adjust the use of the physical space, the Department has granted an approval for a revised license issued under the authority of 55 Pa. Code Ch. 2600 (relating to Personal Care Homes). The approved capacity revision request is a reduction from 150 to 125 . The expiration date of the license remains unchanged.

Since this is a reduction in the previous licensed capacity, you have the right to appeal this decision through a hearing before the Bureau of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Human Services in accordance with 1 Pa.Code Part II, Chs. 31-35. If you decide to appeal, a written request for an appeal must be received within 10 days of the date of this letter by:
