Description of Violation

Resident #1 reported his wallet missing on 11/19/19 and that his bank card was used at an ATM machine located at a nearby 7/11 convenient store on 11/17/19. A total amount of \$1217.50 was withdrawn from his account and direct care staff person "A" was identified as the perpetrator.



PERSONAL CARE HOME STRONGLY DISAGREES WITH THIS VIOLATION AS THE HOME ACTED QUICKLY AND CORRECTLY, ACCORDDING TO 55 Pa. Code §2600 REGULATIONS.

Staff person A was immediately suspended upon further investigation into the incident. At the time of hire, staff person A had a clean criminal background check. Personal care home immediately received statements from all parties involved, including Resident 1, staff person A, and all other employees who worked on the same shift and days as staff person A. All statements were supplied to licensing representative. Personal care home cooperated and worked with Bethlehem Police Department to help identify staff person A. Upon conclusion of the investigation, staff person A was discharged from her duties at the personal care home.

Going forward the Personal Care Home will continue its current practice of providing personal care services in a manner that promotes and protects each of its resident right, consistent with 55 PA. Code §2600.42 (b). As this Personal Care Home continually seeks to improve and heighten its ongoing compliance with the personal care home licensing standard, the personal care home will continue to review the requirements of 55 Pa. Code §2600.42 (b) with all staff during employee orientation and at least annually after. All new hires will continue to have criminal background checks prior to hire. All residents will be reminded and encouraged to keep any belongings in a safe and discreet spot or in the home's safe in the administration office.
