Thank you for your request for a waiver of 55 Pa.Code Ch. 2600 (relating to assisted living residences).

A waiver of 55 Pa.Code § 2600.64(a) (1)-(3) (relating to administrator training and orientation) is hereby granted under the authority of 55 Pa.Code § 2600.19 (relating to waivers).

This waiver is granted under the following conditions:

1. This waiver applies to [REDACTED], employed by Twin Cedar Senior Living located at 364 Little Walker Road, Shohola, Pennsylvania 18458
2. [REDACTED] shall complete the 100-hour standardized Department-approved personal care home administrator training course, which she is scheduled to attend February 2, 2020 through May 2, 2020 and will provide the Department with a copy of documentation of completion of the 100-hour course.
3. [REDACTED] shall complete the Department-approved competency-based personal care home administrator training test with a passing score, which she is scheduled to take on May 2, 2020 and will provide the Department with a copy of documentation of completing the competency-test.

4. [REDACTED] shall attend the Personal Care Home Administrator Orientation, which she is scheduled to attend on May 5, 2020.
5. [REDACTED] shall receive weekly supervision as needed by [REDACTED] who will step down from the administrator position on March 6, 2020 but will remain within the company and available for mentoring, guidance, and assistance until [REDACTED] completes her personal care home administrator training.
6. Documentation of [REDACTED] orientation certificate of attendance, completion of the 100-hour course, completion of the competency-based test and educational qualifications shall be kept by Twin Cedar Senior Living in her personnel file and made available to the Department upon request.
7. This waiver is in effect from March 6, 2020 to May 5, 2020. After May 5, 2020, the home will be expected to fully comply with the regulation.

The Department of Human Services will review this waiver each year during its annual inspection to determine compliance with the preceding conditions. Failure to comply with the conditions of this waiver or with other requirements of 55 Pa.Code Chapter 2600 may result in termination of this waiver or other licensing action.
