Description of Violation

On 6/12/20 Resident #1 reported that staff person A entered [redacted] room and told [redacted] to clean up [redacted] room. Resident #1 told staff person A to give [redacted] some time and staff person A then told resident #1 [redacted] was going to grab [redacted] Resident #1 felt [redacted] was disrespected by staff person A.

Plan of Correction - 07/27/2020

Accept

1. Staff person A was suspended immediately when the allegation was told to a supervisor by the resident. Staff person A was terminated as soon as a phone call from Area Agency of Aging was received, telling us that Staff person A was not allowed to be in contact with the resident.

2. Over the past two weeks in-services have been held for all staff members at Renaissance Forks. Education was staggered to ensure social distancing.

Resident Rights were reviewed in depth, with an extra emphasis on respect and dignity. The staff was reminded that nicknames and even terms of endearment such as "honey" can be disrespectful. Staff were also reminded that residents should not be treated as if they were children or in any way spoken to inappropriately, even if they think that they are joking or teasing.
