227d - Support Plan Medical/Dental

1. Requirements

2600.

227.d. Each home shall document in the resident’s support plan the medical, dental, vision, hearing, mental health or other behavioral care services that will be made available to the resident, or referrals for the resident to outside services if the resident’s physician, physician’s assistant or certified registered nurse practitioner, determine the necessity of these services. This requirement does not require a home to pay for the cost of these medical and behavioral care services.

Description of Violation

The pre-admission screening form and level of care assessment completed by the home on 2/4/2020, documents that Resident 1 has a pacemaker. The support plan developed for Resident 1 on 2/18/2020 does not document the pacemaker or medical care services that will be made available for the resident regarding the pacemaker. On 4/9/2020, the home learned that Resident 1 has a remote monitor for the pacemaker. The Resident's support plan was not revised to include the home's plan to meet the resident's service needs related to the pacemaker monitor.

Plan of Correction

Accept

The support plan developed for resident 1 could not be revised to include the pacemaker or medical care services regarding the pacemaker because at the time of discovery the resident was discharged and the medical record was closed. Active support plans of resident's with a pacemaker were reviewed to ensure medical services regarding the pacemaker were included. Those responsible for the development and updates of resident support plans received education regarding the requirement for medical, dental, vision, hearing, mental health or other behavioral care services to be included in the support plan. A random audit of 10 resident support plans will be completed by the administrator or designee weekly for 3 months to ensure compliance. Completion date for this POC is 9/10/2020 and the audit will continue the following 3 months.
