Staff Person A stated on 12/8/2020 that face masks have been "optional" for staff to wear. This was further evidenced by statements made by visitors to the home and staff members of the home that staff of the home do not wear face masks while working in the home.

May 24, 2021 Additional POC - Going forward, Cornerstone will comply with current health and safety laws as they pertain to the Covid-19 pandemic. Staff is informed on a weekly basis of the emails received and the notices put forth to personal Care Homes from the State. Monthly staff meetings are held when health and safety protocol and procedures are discussed. Residents and staff of Cornerstone have been educated on the importance of continuing to wear a mask when they travel outside of the facility, and if they are talking with any visitors and/or family in the facility. Medical professionals, visitors, and family must wear a mask when they enter the Home and are asked to be socially distant.

The covid-19 vaccines have been provided to residents and staff of Cornerstone by working through the State to have them available, as well as our local pharmacy. We continue to follow safe practices when it comes to wearing masks and being socially distant. We have not had any new positive cases of covid since December and we will continue to test any new resident or staff at the facility, as well as anyone who is showing new symptoms of the the covid-19 virus.
