## 18 - Compliance With Laws

### 1. Requirements

2600.

18. Applicable Health and Safety Laws - A home shall comply with applicable Federal, State and local laws, ordinances and regulations.

#### Description of Violation

*The Order of the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Dept. of Health Directing Long-Term Care Facilities to Implement Measures for Use and Distribution of Personal Protective Equipment, dated August 18, 2020, requires:*

*A. Each facility shall develop, implement, and adhere to policies and procedures that provide for the procurement and distribution of PPE to all staff by ... August 27, 2020.*

*B. The policies and procedures must, at a minimum, include distribution of respirators to staff providing direct patient care to COVID-19 positive and suspected cases and staff assigned to provide direct patient care in COVID-19 units. Furthermore, on October 9, 2020 the Bureau of Human Services Licensing communicated its requirement that Personal Care Homes <Assisted Living Residences> adhere to the Secretary's order.*

*On 12/21/2020, the home did not have written policies and procedures on the distribution and use of respirators (N95 masks) when staff are providing care to a resident who has been diagnosed with or are suspected to have COVID-19. The policy consists solely of guidance via group text messages to staff persons.*

*Per the Order of the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Dept. of Health Requiring Universal Face Coverings, updated November 18, 2020. Section 2 Face Coverings Required*

*Except as provided in Section 3, every individual, age two and older, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall wear a face covering when:*

*A. Indoors or in an enclosed space, where another person or persons who are not members of the individual's household are present in the same space, irrespective of physical distance.*

*On 12/18/2020, direct care staff person A provided care to resident #1 who tested positive for COVID-19 on [REDACTED]. According to staff person A, he/she wears a blue and white surgical mask when providing care to residents.*

- *Follow state and local guild lines for testing both employees and residents at PCH.*
- *Screening of all who enter the facility for s/s of covid, ie: temp checks, questions or observations about s/s, and denial of entry of those with signs.*
- *Proper social distancing of both staff and residents*
- *Cleaning and disinfecting high frequency touched areas and surfaces*
- *Educate staff on proper handwashing and transmission modes ie: coughing, sneezing, touching of surfaces*
- *Educated staff on proper use and wearing PPE and follow CDC guildlines on usage and wearing of PPE with both COVID positive and negative residents and changing PPE in between each residents care.*
- *To avoid transmission within PCH, PCH should use separate staff members for covid positive residents to the best of their ability and work with state and local leaders in implementing plans to separate positive and negative residents within facility.*
