1. Requirements

2600.

82.c. Poisonous materials shall be kept locked and inaccessible to residents unless all of the residents living in the home are able to safely use or avoid poisonous materials.

Description of Violation

On [REDACTED], Resident 1 was taken to the hospital after ingesting laundry detergent that was kept in an unlocked area of the home. Resident 1 is in a Secured Dementia Unit and not assessed to safely avoid poisonous materials according to [REDACTED] DME dated 12/30/2020 and RASP dated 1/1/2021.

Laundry soap dispensers have been installed in a locked cabinet above the washing machines which will prevent this from happening again. All staff were re-trained on proper storage of poisonous materials, sign in sheets attached. All poisonous materials will be kept in locked areas. The Program Manager and the Administrator will monitor for ongoing compliance and safety.
