Resident 1 had two open bottles of Equate-brand Milk of Magnesia stored on his bedside table. Neither Resident 1 nor [REDACTED] roommate is assessed to be able to self-administer medications.

The generic Milk of Magnesia was removed during the inspection. Staff was made aware of the situation and was to watch for OTC medications during the time they are cleaning the rooms. Residents are to be reminded before they go shopping and upon their return from shopping that they are not allowed to keep these products in their room.
