Description of Violation

On 5/7/21 Direct care staff member A pushed Resident #1's forehead back after Resident #1 pushed the staff members stomach. Staff member A did not treat Resident #1 with dignity and respect.

Plan of Correction**Accept**

The staff member in question was immediately suspended following the incident. The staff member resigned upon being placed on suspension. All other Direct Care Staff were retrained on "resident's rights" with emphasis on Dignity and respect. The Unit Manager and Executive Director will continue on an ongoing basis to offer additional trainings to ensure all Direct Care Staff are treating residents with Dignity and respect.
