Your request to waive 55 Pa.Code § 2600.16(d), § 2600.22(1) and (2), § 2600.141(a) and § 2600.224(a) is granted under the authority of 55 Pa.Code § 2600.19 due to Sterling Home LLC choosing to use the preadmission and documentation of medical evaluation forms from Tabula Pro.

**2600.16 Reportable incidents and conditions**

*(d) The home shall submit a final report, on a form prescribed by the Department, to the Department's personal care home regional office immediately following the conclusion of the investigation.*

**2600.22 Admission**

*The following admission documents shall be completed for each resident:*

- (1) Preadmission screening completed prior to admission on a form specified by the Department.*
- (2) Medical evaluation completed 60 days prior to or 30 days after admission on a form specified by the Department.*

**2600.141 Resident medical evaluation and health care**

*(a) A resident shall have a medical evaluation by a physician, physician assistant or certified registered nurse practitioner documented on a form specified by the Department, within 60 days.*

**2600.224 Preadmission screening**

*(a) A determination shall be made within 30 days prior to admission and documented on the Department's preadmission screening form that the needs of the resident can be met by the services provided by the home.*

This waiver is granted under the following conditions:

1. Sterling Home LLC shall use the reportable incident form, preadmission screening form and documentation of medical evaluation form from Tabula Pro in lieu of the Department's forms required for each of the above listed regulations. This is effective May 20, 2021.

The Department of Human Services will review this waiver during its annual inspection to determine compliance with the preceding conditions. Failure to comply with the conditions of this waiver or with other requirements of 55 Pa.Code Chapter 2600 may result in termination of this waiver or other licensing action.
