## 82c - Locking Poisonous Materials

### 1. Requirements

2600.

- 82.c. Poisonous materials shall be kept locked and inaccessible to residents unless all of the residents living in the home are able to safely use or avoid poisonous materials.

### Description of Violation

*The home's policy regarding poisonous items indicates that all poisons are to be locked and out of reach of residents. On 7/20/21, at approximately 11:00 a.m., 2 housekeeping carts were observed on the 2nd and 3rd floors unattended. The top of the carts contained poisonous cleaning items:*

*Cart on 2nd floor contained "Windex" and a cleaner called "Glance." Both cleaners indicated that the cleaners contained poison. Windex Can stated "causes eye irritation, do not swallow. Call poison control." Glance - " IF SWALLOWED: Call a Poison Center (1-800-851-7145) or doctor/physician if you feel unwell. "*

*Cart on 3rd floor contained "Shine Up" - Call Poison Control may cause:*

- Agitation
- Confusion
- Coma (decreased level of consciousness and lack of responsiveness)
- Dizziness
- Breathing difficulty
- Low blood pressure that develops rapidly
- Severe pain in the throat, mouth area, nose, eyes, or ears
- Severe stomach pain
- Throat swelling
- Vomiting,

*"Green Works Bathroom Cleaner with Clorox" stated " Eye irritant First Aid flush eyes Call Doctor. Call Poison Control if ingested."*

### Plan of Correction

Accept

*Housekeeping Department read and sign on storing and securing chemicals properly while in use and when not in use was presented and reviewed with all housekeepers. This read and sign included chemicals being kept locked in the lock box on the housekeeping cart and within eye sight of the housekeeper. If the cart is not able to be locked or chemicals do not fit in lock box, the cart must remain in the apartment with the housekeeper to ensure the chemicals are with in reach and with in eye sight of the housekeeper at all times.*

*PC Admin/Designee will conduct weekly audit rounds on each floor where housekeepers are cleaning for three months and then monthly thereafter for compliance.*

### Directed Plan of Correction:

*To complete the 2 Step Plan of Correction Process, (POC), upon Resubmission of the POC, the Adm will submit a copy of the training outline or training materials and a copy of the Staff Training Signature Sheet.*

*The Adm will also submit a copy of a recently COMPLETED Weekly Audit sheet as evidence of compliance.*
