As the result of your home's recent request to adjust the use of the physical space, the Department has granted an approval for a revised license issued under the authority of 55 Pa. Code Ch. 2600 (relating to Personal Care Homes). The approved capacity revision request is a reduction from 63 to 60. The expiration date of the license remains unchanged.

Any future requests for changes in capacity should be forwarded to the Department for review and consideration in accordance with the applicable regulations. The revised license is enclosed.

Since this is a reduction in the previous licensed capacity, you have the right to appeal this decision through a hearing before the Bureau of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Human Services in accordance with 1 Pa.Code Part II, Chs. 31-35. If you decide to appeal, a written request for an appeal must be received within 10 days of the date of this letter by:
