82c - Locking Poisonous Materials

1. Requirements

2600.

82.c. Poisonous materials shall be kept locked and inaccessible to residents unless all of the residents living in the home are able to safely use or avoid poisonous materials.

Description of Violation

*The shower in the "new" wing of the home had ten bottles of shampoo, conditioner, and body wash which were unlocked and accessible to residents of the home. Two of the bottles, Head and Shoulders 2 in 1 Shampoo and Equate-brand dry scalp shampoo, had manufacturer's labels stating, "If swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away." As the entire building is designated as a secure dementia care unit, none of the residents have been assessed as capable of recognizing and using poisons safely.*

Plan of Correction

Accept

*On September 2, 2021, during this inspection, all containers of soap/shampoo/bodywash were checked for label warnings such as "If swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away", or "Keep out of reach of children", or "Seek medical attention if swallowed", or "contact Poison Control Center if swallowed." On this day, containers with these types of warnings were promptly locked up and made inaccessible to all Residents.*

*On September 2, 2021, Administrator provided verbal reminders to staff in all departments, and placed signs in the shower rooms/bathrooms and break room regarding the importance of checking labels for the above warnings, and keeping poisonous materials locked up and inaccessible to all Residents.*

*On September 2, 2021, Staff were instructed to check all soap/shampoo/bodywash etc., for warning labels similar to above, and to store them safely and appropriately as stated above after each use.*

*On November 04, 2021, regular (not antibacterial) Softsoap was purchased and placed at the sinks in each Resident's bathroom and at the sink in each shower room. Regular (not antibacterial) Softsoap has none of the above warnings on the label.*

*On the first Monday of each month, and more frequently as needed, Administrator, or designee will check shower rooms and Resident bathrooms to ensure that all poisonous materials are locked up and inaccessible to all Residents.*

*On November 12, 2021 this task has been entered into our electronic MAR/documentation system. All checks will be documented via this system – please see the attached tasks as they appear in our electronic MAR/documentation system.*

*All of the above processes are complete and in force.*
