Your request to waive 55 Pa.Code § 64(a)(1) is granted under the authority of 55 Pa.Code § 2600.19 due to [REDACTED] needing to complete the training requirements to serve as a personal care home administrator.

2600.64 Administrator training and orientation

(a) Prior to initial employment as an administrator, a candidate shall successfully complete the following:

- (1) An orientation program approved and administered by the Department.*
- (2) A 100-hour standardized Department-approved administrator training course.*
- (3) A Department-approved competency-based training test with a passing score.*


This waiver is granted under the following conditions:

1. This waiver applies to [REDACTED], employed by Neurorestorative Pennsylvania, located at 6816 Westlake Road, Erie, Pennsylvania 16415, license # 446630.
2. [REDACTED] shall complete the 100-hour standardized Department-approved administrator training course, scheduled from October 29, 2021 through November 21, 2021.
3. [REDACTED] shall take a Department-approved competency-based training test with a passing score scheduled for October 29, 2021.
4. [REDACTED] shall attend the orientation program approved and administered by the Department, scheduled for November 6, 2021.
5. [REDACTED] shall be provided regular supervision from a qualified Pennsylvania personal care home administrator until such time that [REDACTED] meets the training requirements.

6. Documentation of training and educational qualifications of [REDACTED] shall be kept by NeuroRestorative in her personnel file and made available to the Department upon request.
7. This waiver is in effect from October 15, 2021 through November 6, 2021. After November 6, 2021 the home is expected to fully comply with this regulation.

The Department of Human Services will review this waiver during its annual inspection to determine compliance with the preceding conditions. Failure to comply with the conditions of this waiver or with other requirements of 55 Pa.Code Chapter 2600 may result in termination of this waiver or other licensing action.
