89b - Hot Water Temperature

1. Requirements

2600.

89.b. Hot water temperature in areas accessible to the resident may not exceed 120°F.

Description of Violation

The hot water temperature in the common bathroom across from bedroom #3 measured 126.3 degrees Fahrenheit at 10:26 a.m.

The hot water temperature in the common shower/bathroom across from the living room measured 128.43 degrees Fahrenheit at 10:30 a.m.

Plan of Correction

Plan of correction 2600.89.b. Hot Water Temperature :

Hot Water temperature in areas accessible to the resident may not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit as it can cause accidental scalding to the residents.

On 1/5/2022, we had the inspection from the state and the inspector alerted that our hot water temperature in the common bathroom across from bedroom #3 measured 126.3 degrees Fahrenheit and in the common shower/bathroom across from the living room measured 128.43 degrees Fahrenheit at 10:30 a.m. The annual maintenance and inspection of the hot water tank and Furnace was done 1/5/2022 at 6.30 am (on the same day of the state inspection) by the [REDACTED] so we believe that triggered rise in the hot water temperature. The administrator called the [REDACTED] soon after the State Inspection and requested to correct the error and so they came and corrected it by tank control from "B" to "A" to a lower temperature. Now the temperature is 120 degrees Fahrenheit. The administrator will check and record weekly the temperature of the hot water to prevent future violation.
