## 227d - Support Plan Medical/Dental

## 1. Requirements

2600.

227.d. Each home shall document in the resident's support plan the medical, dental, vision, hearing, mental health or other behavioral care services that will be made available to the resident, or referrals for the resident to outside services if the resident's physician, physician's assistant or certified registered nurse practitioner, determine the necessity of these services. This requirement does not require a home to pay for the cost of these medical and behavioral care services.

**Description of Violation**

Resident #1 was admitted on [REDACTED]. The annual assessment for resident #1 indicated that resident has no problem with irritability, judgement, agitation, aggression, or hallucinations. Resident #1's court appointed guardian stated that they purchased a television for Resident #1 and resident #1 put the television in the shower and turned the water on. Guardian also stated resident #1 has delusions. Staff interviews revealed Resident #1 is aggressive, irritable, and has poor judgement at times. It was revealed that if Resident #1 has a cup, they will urinate in the cup and will throw that urine at people for unspecified reasons. These behaviors are not addressed in the residents RASP and there is no plan on how the home will manage these behaviors.

**Plan of Correction****Accept**

RASP was updated while inspector was in the facility.

Moving Forward: Dayshift med tech will do all updates of RASP either behavior or medical. Administrator and dayshift med tech will have a sit-down meeting weekly to discuss changes and administrator will check RASP biweekly to make sure updates are made and for ongoing compliance.
