## 42b - Abuse

**1. Requirements**

2600.

42.b. A resident may not be neglected, intimidated, physically or verbally abused, mistreated, subjected to corporal punishment or disciplined in any way.

**Description of Violation**

On [REDACTED] resident #1 lifted up resident #2's wheelchair causing resident #2 to be dumped to the floor. Resident #2 sustained an injury to the right side of the head which was bleeding as a result of the altercation. Resident #2 was taken to a local hospital for evaluation and treatment. Resident #2 required four stitches to the head before returning to the home. On 1/19/22, resident #1 pushed resident #3 causing resident #3 to suffer a fall to the floor as a result of this altercation. Resident #3 suffered no apparent injuries.

**POC Submission****Accept**

Resident #1 was immediately separated from Resident #2. Resident #2 was transferred to Evangelical Community Hospital and received 4 stitches to head and returned to facility. Both residents were placed on 15 minute checks. PCP of both residents was notified. Medication adjustments made with Resident #1. Spoke with Resident #1's Power of Attorney regarding his behavior issues and recommendation made to seek alternate placement. Since this incident, resident has physically declined and is now under services of Evangelical Hospice. Resident is followed closely by house Physician Assistant and Hospice. Resident is no longer able to ambulate freely throughout the unit. Resident #2 and Resident #3 were also moved to another unit. Executive Director is continuing to monitor situation closely. Power of Attorney and physician aware resident will be discharged if any behavior issues occur.
