On [redacted]/22 at [redacted]pm, Staff Person A told Resident #1 to stop using his/her call bell for assistance so often after Resident #1 used his/her call bell to request assistance changing his/her clothes. Resident #1 expressed to family and staff that this interaction with Staff Person A upset the resident.

Plan of Correction

Do Not Accept

After a thorough investigation was concluded, it was decided that although the incident was not on the level of resident abuse, the incident did rise to the level of not meeting Moravian Village standards of behavior toward a resident/family member/or staff. Staff Person A was reassigned immediately to another department that does not have direct resident care contact. Staff Person A also completed a Resident Rights course and Stress Management course on [redacted]/22 through the Moravian Village education via Zenith.
