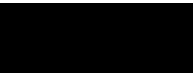

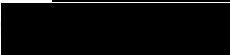

15a - Resident Abuse Report

1. Requirements

2600.

15.a. The home shall immediately report suspected abuse of a resident served in the home in accordance with the Older Adult Protective Services Act (35 P. S. § § 10225.701—10225.707) and 6 Pa. Code § 15.21—15.27 (relating to reporting suspected abuse) and comply with the requirements regarding restrictions on staff persons.

Description of Violation

On [REDACTED] approximately [REDACTED] resident #1 reported to staff person B that, at approximately [REDACTED] that morning, staff person A had pinched [REDACTED] leg while applying lotion and that staff person A provides rough care. However, this allegation of abuse was not reported to the Area Agency on Aging until [REDACTED]

POC Submission

Accept (JW - 10/03/2022)

-Staff Member A was immediately suspended on [REDACTED] when Administrator was notified of allegations of abuse from [REDACTED] until the completion of an internal investigation within PSL also contingent on the investigations with Area Aging and DHS. Administrator sent reportable to DHS on [REDACTED] and contacted Protective Services immediately.

-On 7/1/2022 Area Aging, DHS, and PSL concluded that there was no abuse and they were closing the investigation.

- Administrator spoke to Resident A regarding investigation, informed them that the allegations were found unfounded. Resident A was okay with Staff member A returning to work.

-Staff member A was able to return to work depending on the completion of training's. Staff member A completed training's on 7/1/2022 and returned to work on [REDACTED] Documentation of training's attached.

-- All Staff were directed to review PSL Reporting Policy on [REDACTED] documentation of staff sign off sheet attached. All staff also completed online Relias training, "Preventing, Recognizing, and reporting Abuse, Protecting Resident Rights training's" Documentation of staffs completions attached.

-On 7/14/2022, Protective Services completed a training with all staff regarding abuse, how to recognize abuse, and how to report. Attached sign in sheet of training attached.

15.b. If there is an allegation of abuse of a resident involving a home's staff person, the home shall immediately develop and implement a plan of supervision or suspend the staff person involved in the alleged incident.

Description of Violation

On [REDACTED] at approximately [REDACTED] resident #1 reported to staff person B that, at approximately [REDACTED] m. that morning, staff person A had pinched [REDACTED] leg while applying lotion and that staff person A provides rough care.

15b - Supervisor Plan (continued)

However, this allegation of abuse was not reported to the Area Agency on Aging until [REDACTED]. However, the home did not immediately develop and implement a plan of supervision or suspend the staff person involved in the alleged incident. Staff person A completed the shift till 8:00 am.

-Staff Member A was immediately suspended on [REDACTED] when Administrator was notified of allegations of abuse until the completion of an internal investigation within PSL also contingent on the investigations with Area Aging and DHS.

-Administrator completed interviews with involved staff member and resident regarding allegations. Administrator came to the conclusion on [REDACTED] that allegations were unfounded. Protective Services and DHS also investigated and found the allegations unfounded.

-Staff member A was able to return to work depending on the completion of training's. Staff member A completed training's on [REDACTED] and returned to work on [REDACTED]. Documentation of training's attached.

-Administrator immediately reviewed and educated self on Reporting Abuse Policy on 6/30/2022. Administrator also completed online Relias training about Reporting Abuse. PSL Policy on Reporting abuse and Online training attached.

-Staff member B completed required Relias online training about Reporting Abuse. All staff also completed the required Relias training on Reporting Abuse. Attached documentation is provided of all staffs training and completion.

-Administrator educated all staff on 7/14/2022 of PSL Guidelines regarding Reporting of Abuse. Documentation of training attached of review of Abuse Investigations/Reporting Policies that were reviewed with all staff and acknowledgment of review.

-Protective Services completed training on Reporting Abuse on 7/14/2022. Documentation of training attached.
