42b - Abuse

1. Requirements

2600.

42.b. A resident may not be neglected, intimidated, physically or verbally abused, mistreated, subjected to corporal punishment or disciplined in any way.

Description of Violation

On 5/13/22 Resident #1 hit direct care staff member A. Staff member A retaliated and struck the resident back in the shoulder. The staff member proceeded to say to the resident "don't hit me because I swing back."

Plan of Correction

Directed

Incident was witnessed by a family member of another resident. Witness immediatly came to the Executive Dir. office to report the incident. The ED along with the DON immediatly went to the area where the resident and staff member where removed the staff member from the area and took [REDACTED] the the ED office. The DON remained with the resident to examine [REDACTED] and evaluate [REDACTED] for any injuries. The ED and HR sat with the staff member and got [REDACTED] statement of the incident. Staff member was immediatly placed on leave and escorted from the building. It was determined that the resident was unharmed from the incident. And due to the residents diagnosis of demensia had no recolection of the incident. At this point the PA State Police were notified and an officer responded investigated and determined that no charges were to be brought. An abuse report was filed with the Lehigh County of Aging and an investigation was conducted by them. [REDACTED] also placed a call to [REDACTED] as reference that we were following all protocols and regulations for the incident.

It was determined that the incident did occur thru the witness statement but also by the statement provided by the staff member. Due to Genesis Health policy the staff member was terminated.

Staff are trained yearly on the types of abuse and how to handle a potential abuse situation should it occur.

The Administrator will oversee reporting of abuse and compliance with policies and procedures intended to reduce/minimize/ eliminate situations of abuse, exploitation, abandonment and neglect in the home.
