On [REDACTED]/22, at approx. [REDACTED] p.m., resident #1, who has a [REDACTED] diagnosis, was found outside the home near the road [REDACTED]. Resident #1 was subsequently admitted to the hospital where [REDACTED] was diagnosed with and treated for a dislocated shoulder. Resident #1's Assessment and Support Plan dated [REDACTED] 22, indicate the resident has a moderate problem with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] with a plan to meet this service need as "staff to know whereabouts at all times/redirect/cue/remind/assist" resident as needed.

unable to independently transfer out of this chair with his/her legs raised in this manner. Resident #1's most recent Assessment and Support Plan dated 7/14/22, assesses resident as having a moderate problem with [REDACTED] with a description of service need as "[REDACTED]". The plan to meet this service need was "staff to know whereabouts at all times/redirect/cue/remind/assist" resident as needed.

2. If the condition of the resident significantly changes prior to the annual assessment.
3. At the request of the Department upon cause to believe that an update is required.

Description of Violation

Resident #1's most recent assessment, dated [REDACTED] 22, indicates resident #1's ambulating needs as minimal with a plan to meet the services need as "Keep cane within reach, staff to offer arm for balance PRN, monitor for changes notify MD of changes. However, multiple staff members to include Staff Member C indicate the resident has required wheelchair use for the past several weeks [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

Resident #1's most recent assessment also indicates resident's transferring service need as "unable to do independently [REDACTED]", with a plan to meet this service need as "assist resident with transfers as needed, monitor for changes notify MD of concerns". However, Staff Member C indicates resident #1 has required a two person assist during
