1. Requirements

2600.

101.j. Each resident shall have the following in the bedroom:

7. An operable lamp or other source of lighting that can be turned on at bedside.

Description of Violation

Resident 1 did not have a lamp near their bedside. Resident 2's lamp was not working at time of inspection.

POC Submission**Accept (MM - 10/28/2022)**

Resident 1 was breaking either glass from the bulb or the lamp itself, 3 of them had been placed on the bedtable and had gotten broken by the resident, 1 of them was a plastic lamp, until we could not trust to have a lamp by [REDACTED] bedside without [REDACTED] getting injured. The hallway light was left on and [REDACTED] door cracked open (about an inch) for the light into [REDACTED] room. The inspector noticed there was no lamp, we explained how and why and then showed [REDACTED] the wall lamp and [REDACTED] said they were allowed. It was placed in [REDACTED] room immediately. The new light in [REDACTED] room is checked each shift (1st, 2nd, and 3rd) to make sure it is working properly. It was corrected before the inspector had left.

Resident 2 had just been moved from [REDACTED] into a room with another resident. The light bulb did work, it must have blown or was bumped during the move. The bulb was replaced during the inspection.
