103f - Refrigerator/Freezer Temps

1. Requirements

2600.

103.f. Food requiring refrigeration shall be stored at or below 40°F. Frozen food shall be kept at or below 0°F. Thermometers are required in refrigerators and freezers.

Description of Violation

At 10:04am in building A, the temperature in the kitchen refrigerator was 46 degrees Fahrenheit.

At 10:12am in building A, the temperature in the basement freezer marked for weekend frozen food was 11 degrees Fahrenheit.

Repeat Violation: 10/15/21

Plan of Correction

Accept ([redacted] - 12/22/2022)

Maintenance turned up the kitchen refrigerator temperature on 11/22/22 at 8pm. The Cook checked the temperature on 11/23/22 at 9am and the temperature was at 40 degrees fahrenheit.

Maintenance turned the temperature up in the freezer marked weekend food on 11/22/22 at 8pm. The Cook rechecked the temperatures on 11/23/22 at 9am and it was at 0 degrees Fahrenheit.

The Cook was retrained on Reg. 2600.103.f on 11/27/22 by the Administrator.

The Cook posted temperature charts on the freezers and refrigerators on 11/27/22 and will check the temperatures daily beginning 11/27/22 and daily thereafter.

The Administrator will check for compliance of regulation 2600.103.f. beginning on 11/27/22 and monthly thereafter.
