183d - Prescription Current

1. Requirements

2600.

183.d. Only current prescription, OTC, sample and CAM for individuals living in the home may be kept in the home.

Description of Violation

The Personal Care Home staff on the evening of [REDACTED] received medications from [REDACTED] Pharmacy LTC for resident #1 who is not a resident of the Personal Care Home. Resident #1 resides in a Supportive Living Unit which is not on the grounds of the personal care home but is operated at another location as an unlicensed community program and is owned by individuals who operate Eagle Valley Personal Care Home.

The medications were [REDACTED] tablets, [REDACTED] mg tablets and 20 tablets of [REDACTED]. These medications according to the Home's Administrator were to be locked up in the facility's South wing nurse station and to be given to a Resident Care Coordinator the next day on 9/3/22 who assists resident #1 in the Supportive Living apartment. On 9/3/22, a Resident Care Coordinator came to Eagle Valley Personal Care Home around 9:15-9:30 AM to secure the medications belonging to the Supportive Living resident who is identified in this violation as resident #1. The 20 [REDACTED] tablets medication belonging to resident #1 were found to be missing. The medication policy of the personal care home indicated medications received for the Supportive Living residents were to be locked up in the South wing nurse station and given to the Supportive Living Resident Care Coordinator ASAP or the next day. The home failed to comply with regulation 2600.183 (d) which states " Only current prescription, OTC, sample and CAM for individuals living in the home may be kept in the home."

Plan of Correction

Accept ([REDACTED] 12/15/2022)

Eagle Valley Personal Care Home, Inc. will not accept medications drops for the Supportive Living Homes. The mail drop location has been removed from this facility. The staff of Eagle Valley Personal Care Home, Inc. No longer have any responsibility in the medication delivery system for the group homes.

Our immediate response to this deficiency was:

1. Communicated to the Resident Care Coordinator of the Supportive Living Homes to no longer have medications delivered to this location. The RCC of the Supportive Living homes communicated this immediate change to Thompson's Pharmacy.
2. The locked bin that was purchased for the Supportive Living resident/s medications was relocated to one of their facilities.
3. Policy K 1a was updated to reflect we no longer accept medications for any residents that do not reside in this facility.

See attached K 1a policy with signatures by each Team Leader who were the responsible parties for accepting medications.
