1. Requirements

2600.

42.c. A resident shall be treated with dignity and respect.

Description of Violation

Staff person "A" was reported by numerous residents and staff to be verbally aggressive, irritated and frustrated with resident's while providing residents with care. Through interviews with residents, it was determined that many residents would avoid requesting assistance from staff person "A" due to feeling intimidated by Staff person "A".

Plan of Correction

Accept (████ - 02/09/2023)

Staff person "A" has been an employee for over 10 years. Staff person "A" has been working 60 + hours per week for the past year.

Staff person "A" has had hours reduced, duties changed with less interaction with residents, is enrolled in a PA approved eight hour online training and is working on self improvement education to combat burnout and mood enhancement, with the guidance of the LPN, Administrator and facility medical director.

Administrator is interviewing staff and residents on a weekly basis to monitor behavior.

Administrator will continue with monthly interviews of residents after course completion for ongoing compliance.
