1. Requirements

2600.

23.a. A home shall provide each resident with assistance with ADLs as indicated in the resident's assessment and support plan.

Description of Violation

Resident #1's assessment and support plan (RASP) dated [REDACTED] states the Resident #1 requires some physical assistance with transfers in/out of bed/chair, stating specifically that "staff will assist resident with transfer out of bed to stand with walker." On [REDACTED], Resident #1 used their call bell to request assistance with transferring out of bed to stand, and Staff Person A refused to assist Resident #1 after several requests by Resident #1. Staff Person A repeatedly told Resident #1 to try to stand by himself/herself.

2. Requirements

2600.

42.b. A resident may not be neglected, intimidated, physically or verbally abused, mistreated, subjected to corporal punishment or disciplined in any way.

Description of Violation

On [REDACTED], Resident #1 used their call bell to request assistance transferring out of bed to use their walker to go to the bathroom. Staff Person A refused to assist Resident #1 to stand after multiple requests by the resident, telling the resident to try to sit up by themselves. Per interview with the resident, after the resident sat up about halfway, Staff Person A pulled on Resident #1's arm roughly with both hands, causing 2 lacerations on Resident #1's left arm.
