1. Requirements

2600.

81.b. Wheelchairs, walkers, prosthetic devices and other apparatus used by residents must be clean, in good repair and free of hazards.

Description of Violation

Resident 1's bed is equipped with an uncovered enabler bar with an opening that measures 7" across and poses an entrapment risk to the resident.

The home does not have a written policy that addresses the placement of, routine checking of, or the continued need for assistive devices including enabler bars.

Plan of Correction

Accept [redacted] - 02/07/2023)

- 1) Bed enabler was removed immediately on 2-1-23 by maintenance department employee [redacted] on [redacted] s bed at [redacted] request. PCP was updated on 2-1-23 and order was discontinued for bed enabler.
- 2) An audit of all beds will be completed to check for any other bed enablers that is uncovered by the nursing staff and is projected to be completed on 2-10-23.
- 3) An updated policy will be developed for the routine checking of bed enablers and the continued need for assistive devices and will be completed by March 1,2023
- 4) A monthly audit will continue by Nursing staff each month to ensure all bed enablers are safe, secure and covered.
