42.b. A resident may not be neglected, intimidated, physically or verbally abused, mistreated, subjected to corporal punishment or disciplined in any way.

Description of Violation

On [redacted] resident #1 reported having a sexual encounter with staff person A in the home several months prior during staff person A's work shift.

Plan of Correction

Accept [redacted] - 03/23/2023)

Immediately, on [redacted], upon receiving resident #1's report of a sexual encounter that occurred months previous with a staff person this Administrator contacted the Pennsylvania State Police and made a report of the incident. On [redacted] Staff person A was informed that they were removed from the work schedule. On [redacted] Northumberland County Aging and Adult Protective Services was notified of the incident. On [redacted] the resident's casemanager was informed of the incident. On [redacted] the residents designated person was notified of the incident. On [redacted] the PSP came to the home to investigate the resident's report. On [redacted] APS representative came to the home to assure the resident's well being. On [redacted] the resident's casemanager came to offer any needed support. The resident was offered victim services, which she declined. The resident does have established psychiatric care and counseling services for support. STD testing was scheduled and determined negative. Upon hire, the home had conducted a criminal background check for staff person A that did not list any prohibitive offenses. The home has assured that the resident was assisted with any desired additional services or supports. The home has surveyed the remaining residents regarding any other inappropriate conduct from staff person A and there were no additional complaints of any kind. The home has followed all required steps in reporting the incident and will monitor the situation for a final determination. The PSP continue to conduct the investigation and staff person A has not returned to their work position.
