Description of Violation

Resident #1 was yelled at, and foul language was used by staff person A during an incident on [REDACTED]. Staff Person A accused resident #1 of coming out of another resident's room. The resident was not treated with dignity and respect.

Plan of Correction**Accept (MM - 03/20/2023)**

On [REDACTED] the coworker was suspended and no additional contact was made. The facility Associate Executive Director completed an investigation. The coworker's employment was terminated on [REDACTED]. The resident was happy to know that no additional contact with this employee would be had. The resident and family were provided reassurance that no additional contact with this employee would be made and that all staffed would be retrained. The resident is doing well and on 03/16/23 moved to Independent Living as per [REDACTED] goals after recouping from a surgical procedure. The Associate Executive Director held a training for all staff on Residents Rights with an emphasis on Dignity and Respect and Abuse and Neglect. The Associate Executive Director held this training between 12/27/22 and 12/29/22. The Campus Executive Director will meet with two residents a week for 4 weeks to ensure they residents feel safe and treated with dignity and respect beginning the week of 03/20/23.
