2600.

Description of Violation

Resident #1 is prescribed wound care, cleanse wound with soap and water, pat dry, apply skin prep to peri wound, apply betadine to wound bed and apply border gauze twice a day. Records indicated that resident #1 received this medication's administration on [REDACTED], at [REDACTED]. However, the medication's administration was not indicated on resident #1's medication administration record on [REDACTED], at [REDACTED]. The field was blank.

Immediately Administrator spoke with the staff person who did not record the administration of wound care on 3/13/23 @6:00pm. The staff person was given written notice and retrained on the DHS Medication Administration policies and procedures to include the importance of proper documentation. The Administrator will be checking the MAR on a monthly basis beginning 03/31/2023, to ensure proper documentation of administration has been made accordingly to the physician's order.
