81b - Resident Personal Equipment

1. Requirements

2600.

81.b. Wheelchairs, walkers, prosthetic devices and other apparatus used by residents must be clean, in good repair and free of hazards.

Description of Violation

On 6/16/23 at approximately 11:33 a.m. resident #2 in resident room [REDACTED] had a pair of inverted L-shaped enabler rails affixed to either side of the bed that were unwrapped, unsecured, and had two openings, one that measured approximately four-inches wide by eighteen-inches high, the second opening measured approximately four-inches wide by six-inches high at the widest point and both openings created a risk for limb entanglement.

Plan of Correction

To ensure compliance with regulation 2600.81.b, which states that wheelchairs, walkers, prosthetic devices, and other apparatus used by residents must be clean, in good repair, and free of hazards, the enabler rails were removed on 6/16/23 at the exit of the surveyors. Moving forward all beds will be checked weekly to ensure no bedrails are present.

2. Requirements

2600.

162.e. A change to a menu shall be posted in a conspicuous and public place in the home and shall be accessible to a resident in advance of the meal. Meal substitutions shall be made in accordance with § 2600.161 (relating to nutritional adequacy).

Description of Violation

On 6/16/23 the posted menu for lunch indicated that the following menu items would be served:

Pepperoni Pizza

Assorted Fruit

Peas

Beverage of Choice

However, direct staff person A and resident interviews indicated the lunch menu 6/16/23 was changed. The change to the lunch menu was not posted in a conspicuous and public place in the home in advance of the meal, and the residents with mechanical soft food preparation needs were served chopped Salisbury steak, mixed vegetables, and mashed potatoes and gravy instead of the posted menu items.

Plan of Correction

Accept [REDACTED] - 06/29/2023)

To remain in continued compliance with regulation 2600.162.e. A change to a menu shall be posted in a conspicuous and public place in the home and shall be accessible to a resident in advance of the meal. Meal substitutions shall be made by § 2600.161 (relating to nutritional adequacy), the dietary and personal care staff were educated on the importance of knowing what meals are being served and providing residents with options and knowledge of what they are being served. At the time of this reporting, the dietician was unwilling to follow along with compliance and will be replaced as soon as possible.

*Moving forward, all meal choices, including mechanical soft/puree. will be posted alongside the general menu. All menus will be checked daily and changes will be posted and audibly addressed to residents.*
