103f - Refrigerator/Freezer Temps**1. Requirements**

2600.

103.f. Food requiring refrigeration shall be stored at or below 40°F. Frozen food shall be kept at or below 0°F. Thermometers are required in refrigerators and freezers.

Description of Violation

At 9:23 a.m., the chest freezer labeled "Freezer 2" in the home's basement had three thermometers in it with the lowest one measuring 5 degrees Fahrenheit. At 9:57 a.m., the lowest temperature of the three thermometers in this chest freezer measured two degrees Fahrenheit.

Plan of Correction**Accept ([REDACTED] - 09/05/2023)**

On 8/22/23 all of the food was removed from freezer 2 and placed in a different freezer that read 0 degrees F.

A new freezer was purchased on 9/4/23 and will be delivered to the facility on 9/8/23.

The new freezer displays the temperature on the outside of the freezer and will alarm if it goes above 0 degrees F.

Each staff person has been trained on refrigerator/freezer temperature regulations. Documentation of training will be kept.

Once per shift one staff person will check the temperature of all refrigerators/freezers and document the current temperature. If the temperature is not within regulation guidelines staff has been instructed to report their findings immediately to administer [REDACTED] and or co-owner [REDACTED].

A log of daily refrigerator/freezer temperatures will be kept.

[REDACTED] and or [REDACTED] will check temperature logs daily to ensure temperatures are remaining within regulated guidelines.
