1. Requirements

Description of Violation

On [redacted] /2023 around 10:35 AM, resident #1 fell in [redacted] room, was noted with [redacted] and was sent out to an emergency room, [redacted] The home did not report this incident to the department.

Plan of Correction

Accept [redacted] - 10/06/2023)

On 09/20/2023, The Executive Director (ED) submitted an incident report to the Department of Human Services (DHS) regarding a fall that resulted in Resident #1 returning to the community [redacted] /2023.

On 09/12/2023, The ED met with the leadership team and reviewed reporting requirements. ED reviewed all reportable incidents to DHS and reiterated that all incidents especially those resulting in a serious injury must be reported to DHS within 24 hours.

On 09/12/2023, The ED and all designees reviewed all complaints that are received and appropriate to be reported to DHS within a 24-hour timeframe of being notified.

On 09/21/2023, The ED held a Team Member Townhall meeting to review the reporting guidelines.

On 09/29/2023 and ongoing, This Plan of Correction will be discussed and evaluated (for up to 3 months) by the ED and Coordinators at the Quality Management (QAPI) meeting to verify it is still effective. If not effective, it will be amended and a new POC and training will be implemented and monitored to verify the violation does not occur again.
